

Press release: Results of the Frankfurt International Trophy



The Frankfurt wine, beer and spirits competition is proud to present its 2025 award-winners. German products impress at this year's tasting:

- The world's best wine comes from Greece
- The world's best beer comes from Germany
- The world's best spirits comes from Germany

Mainz, 16 April 2025 For this 9th edition of the Frankfurt International Trophy, which took place on 04-05 April, organiser Armonia Deutschland GmbH once again brought 500 tasters to the historic hall in Frankfurt's Palmengarten.

Wines and beers were evaluated by a jury composed of international experts, such as sommeliers and oenologists, and enlightened amateurs representing the tastes of future consumers. The spirits competition allows only experts to taste and judge the samples.

Almost 3,500 wines, beers and spirits from 44 countries were examined at the same time. In all, 1,143 wines, beers and spirits were awarded one of the prestigious medals. Of these, 128 samples received Grand Gold (from 92 points).

After awarding the medals, the competition then elected the best wine, beer and spirit from each country, and the best from all countries combined. This year it was a Greek wine that won the trophy for the world's best wine!

German wines impressed the jury and won a total of 212 medals. Austria follows with 117 medals. France took third place this year with 116 medals. It is followed by Italy with 110 medals, Spain with 89, Greece with 25 and Portugal with 23 medals.

With 78 award-winning beers, Germany retains its lead over its neighbour France with 35 awards. Italy took third place with 14 award-winning beers. It is followed by the Poland and Spain with 11 beers each.

With 64 awards, Germany clearly leads the ranking for spirits, followed by France with 37 medals, Austria with 23 medals, Italy with 16 medals and Belgium and with 15 medals.

About the Frankfurt International Trophy

The Frankfurt International Trophy (FIT) is a competition for high-quality wines, beers and spirits. It is the largest international competition in Germany with juries composed of international experts and experienced amateurs. The competition is open to all the world's wines, beers and spirits.

It is organised by Armonia Deutschland GmbH in Mainz.

The Frankfurt International Trophy is ISO 9001-certified and authorised to award medals to only one-third of the samples presented, to guarantee producers and consumers of a rigorous selection.

The wine competition is certified by the Hesse ministry responsible for the environment, climate, agriculture and consumer protection, which authorises the use of medals in marketing wines.

Every year the Frankfurt International Trophy is presided over by a well-known, Michelin-starred chef whose responsibility it is to promote the competition in the restaurant world.
